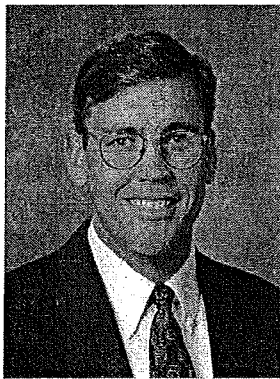
### **Family**
