“Do You Understand the Local Church?” A Preview of Our 2012 Lectureship Book

The church of Christ was established on the first Day of Pentecost following the Lord's resurrection (Acts 2:1-41). The word “church,” as it relates to the body of Christ, is used two ways in Scripture: (1) as the universal body of Christ, including all members in every part of the world (Mt. 16:18); and (2) as a local body of Christ, identified by its ownership (Rom. 16:16; 1 Cor. 1:2), by its location (Gal. 1:2; Rev. 2:8, 12, 18; 3:1, 7), or by those of whom it consists (Rom. 16:4; 1 Cor. 14:33; Col. 4:16). This “local body” aspect of the church is the focus of this coming lectureship and book.

When studying the Biblical doctrine of the church (sometimes called “Ecclesiology”), it is often easy to overlook the church of Christ on the local level. There is great attraction (and value) in analyzing the rich and sweeping passages that paint the beauty of the universal body of Christ, such as that which Jesus promised in Matthew 16:18-19 or as Paul expounded in his epistles to the Ephesians and Colossians. However, a serious look at what the Bible has to say about the local church often falls through the cracks.

The church of Christ is the final manifestation of God's kingdom this side of eternity (Mt. 16:18-19, 28; Mk. 9:1; Lk. 24:49; Acts 1:8; 2:1-41, 47 cf. Col. 1:13; 1 Thes. 2:12; Heb. 12:28; Rev. 1:9). Christ's universal church, or kingdom, will never die (Dan. 2:44; Mt. 16:8—“the gates of hell shall not prevail against it”). Unfortunately, however, local churches of Christ die or disband far too often. Why is this? Could it be that members of those churches do not understand the local church as God ordained and established it? Usually, if people know better, they will do better; unless, of course, they are completely apathetic for the cause of Christ. This lectureship and book seek to eliminate

the excuse of ignorance by pointing to Biblical principles and practical applications that will keep local churches living, active, and desirous of planting more local churches in view of eternity.

The majority of this book will contain the sermon manuscripts that will be preached January 16-19, 2012. The first section will focus on the local church as God brought it from his eternal purpose to an established institution upon this earth for the benefit of humanity. The second section will deal with practical aspects of how humanity is to function within the local church, beginning with the understanding of Christ's complete sovereignty over the local church, continuing with how that translates into fulfilling the various roles of functions within the local church, and concluding with a study of practical insights from some key congregations featured in the New Testament. The third section will contain our afternoon forums, which will examine functional issues and the local church; factors that can make local churches weaker or stronger; preaching and the local church; and local churches and evangelism.

This book will be a valuable source on an often overlooked subject, whose understanding or lack of understanding has serious ramifications both in this life and in the life to come. We urge each reader to seriously consider and study the material that will be presented so that we "be...not unwise, but understanding what the will of the Lord is" concerning the local church of Christ (Eph. 5:17). May the Lord bless all who will read and apply the God-given principles contained within the pages of our 2012 lectureship book!
