Dear brother Stearsman,

How are you doing today? Just great I hope and pray. I trust this letter found you in good health (Ill John 2) and doing well.

I am remaining faithful to the Lord (I Cor, 4:2) and doing well. Presently I'm a little ill with the pollen and flu going around; with the Lord's help things will be alright.

Brother Stearsman, I want to take this time to say thank you for training me to understand more of what it really means to be a gospel preacher. The lessons that I learned inside and outside of the classroom have prepared me to take the gospel to the State of South Carolina. As I work everyday in the vineyard I realize that the kingdom will not grow any faster than we stabilize/strengthen churches. I also am sure that it takes time to grow churches. Churches will not grow any faster than it has faithful and trained leadership.

It is also interesting that many of the issues that were brought up in class such as the divorce and remarriage issue, musical instruments during worship, "Jesus only", eating in a "church" building, and babies

being born in sin, are just a few of the doctrinal errors that I've been confronted with. Because of my training at the school of preaching, I had no problem in giving a Bible answer to these false doctrines.

God has given me the opportunity to preach twice a month at the Park Street congregation, preach over the radio (1170 AM) and lead a weekly Bible study at the University of South Carolina (USC). In February, I spoke at the youth rally in Savannah (GA) and in March I spoke at the youth rally in Charlotte (NC). The lessons I learned in the Christian Evidence class and the Ethics class proved most helpful in helping the young people.

Brother Stearsman, as I close this letter I just want to say THANKS AGAIN and keep up the great work! Many will be eternally grateful for the training, love and wisdom that is so faithfully given at the Florida School of Preaching.
